SANCTION: Held under sanction of Colorado Swimming, Inc. of USA, LSC
Colorado Zone 4 Sanction #2008-009H

FACILITIES: Ouray Hot Springs Swimming Pool
Ouray, Colorado 81427
25 meter pool with 8 lanes

TIMING: There will be a semi automatic timing system and two timers for each lane and two order of finish judges for each event. Each team will be responsible for providing lane timers.

SCHEDULE: Warm-up for Session 1 9:00 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. as per USA Swimming Guidelines. Session 2 will start 10 minutes after the completion of Session 1. Officials and Coaches meeting at 9:45 a.m. Meet starts at 10:00 a.m. and continues until completed.

RULES: Current USA Swimming rules govern the procedures of the meet and warm-up. Age as of the day of competition will determine the swimmer's age group. There will be timed finals only. Each swimmer may enter 4 individual events plus 2 relays in Session 1. Each swimmer may also swim 1 event in Session 2. Swimmers must provide two timers and their counters for Session 2 events. Session 2 events will be swum fastest to slowest alternating girls and boys. For all sessions, at the meet referees discretion, events may be combined.

ELIGIBILITY: USA member athletes in Zone 4 holding a 2008 membership card.

SCORING: Team points will not be kept.

ENTRY FEES: \$3.00 per swimmer for each individual event (\$.15 will go to the Western Slope fund). \$4.50 per relay. \$1.00 pool use fee per swimmer. Please make check payable to Ouray Swim Team.

PROCEDURE: We will be using the Meet Manager computer program. Entries can be emailed to jlrimmer@lornet.com A hard copy of the entries, sorted by swimmer's name, and entry fees must be mailed to the entry chairman prior to the meet.

Please - short course meter times only.

Late entries for the pre-seeded meet will be accepted until 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, June 11th, with a \$5.00 late entry fee per individual; all other fees apply. All entry fees must be paid before results and awards will be released to the coach. **NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED ON THE MORNING OF THE MEET. NO EXCEPTIONS.**

RESULTS: Programs will be provided to coaches and officials. Results will be posted during the meet with a copy for each team following the meet.

OFFICIALS/

TIMERS: Each team is asked to provide officials and timers to assist with the running of the meet. Please send names of available officials with your entries.

SPECIAL

INFO: No smoking on pool deck or any area frequented by swimmers. The side pool gate to the west of the lobby will open at 8:30 a.m. on meet day. Swimming will be available during the meet for those attending the meet and anyone who wishes to remain at the pool after the meet is over is invited to stay without paying any additional entrance fees to the pool.

Our pool rules state that anyone under the age of seven (7) must be within arms reach of an adult at all times. (This does not apply when in the lanes competing.) The lifeguards will remove anyone not complying with our pool rules. **Please make swimmers, parents and spectators aware of this in order to avoid problems that have occurred in the past.**

There will be a heating area for the 8 and under events only. All other swimmers must report to their assigned lanes at the proper times

The City of Ouray will be allowing free camping for swim families, and guests, at the Rotary Park. Rotary Park is located 1 mile north of the pool on Highway 550, the east side. There are public restrooms but no showers. Showers are available at the pool.
