- Sanction:** Held under the sanction of USA Swimming; Sanction # 2009-026
- Sponsored by:** Brighton Bullfrogs Swim Team Inc.
- Date & Time:** Warm-ups: 8-8:50 am, Saturday April 4, 2009
Meet start: 9:00 am, Saturday, April 4, 2009
- Location:** Brighton High School Pool, 565 S. 8th Ave, Brighton, CO (southwest corner of 8th and Southern, enter parking lot from Southern St.).
- Facility:** Indoor, 25-yard, 6-lane pool. Warm down available in diving well.
- Timing:** Electronic timing with touch-pads, back-up buttons, and manual timers on each lane.
- Eligibility:** Open to all swimmers, 12 years of age and under, holding a 2009 USA Swimming membership card. Any swimmer that appears on the CSI exceptions report without registration must come to the meet prepared to show their card. NO deck registrations will be accepted.
- Entry Limits:**
- Each swimmer may enter 5 individual events (Brighton Bullfrogs Swim Team Inc reserves the right to limit entries to stay in the four-hour rule).
 - The meet will be limited to 250 swimmers.
- Entry Fees:**
- Pool Surcharge: \$5.00 per swimmer participating in the meet.
Event Charge: \$3.60 per swimmer per individual event (\$.60 per individual swim goes to CSI).
- NOTE: Checks for team entry fees shall be made payable to: Brighton Bullfrogs.
- Entry Procedure:** To participate in this meet, teams shall provide the following to the Entry Coordinator (see contact information below) prior to the entry deadline:
- The completed Colorado Swimming, Inc., Meet Verification Form with an original signature.
- AND**
- A check for the entry fees for the team.
- AND**
- Entries for individual swimmers shall be prepared using Hy-Tek software. This can be e-mailed or mailed. Participating teams are responsible for the accuracy of the entries.
- Entry Deadline:** All entries MUST BE RECEIVED by Friday, March 27, 2009. Late entries will not be accepted.
- Rules:**
- Current USA Swimming rules will govern at the meet.
 - The meet referee will be the final authority for all conduct of the meet.
 - All events will be timed finals.
 - The meet will be pre-seeded
 - The age of the swimmer on the day of the meet will determine the swimmer's age group.
 - Unsportsmanlike conduct and lack of respect for property are grounds for dismissal of swimmers and/or spectators for the remainder of the meet.
 - Swimmers will be held responsible for damages that they have caused.
 - There will be NO SMOKING in the pool area.
 - Glass containers are not allowed in the pool area.
- Warm-ups:** Lane assignments for warm-ups will be posted at the pool on the morning of the meet. Coaches will have control of the warm-up lanes. Warm-ups will be conducted in accordance with established CSI safety procedures.

Concessions: The concession stand will be open during the meet and will be offering a variety of snacks and drinks.

Scoring: 16-13-12-11-10-9-7-5-4-3-2-1

Awards: High Point Trophies for 1st through 6th for ages 6 and under, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12. In case of ties for high point trophies, the following tiebreakers shall apply:

- Swimmer that swam the most yards. If it is the same then:
- Swimmer with the smallest cumulative time for all events.

High-Point Trophies will be presented to the top six swimmers of each age group at the conclusion of the meet. There may be a fun relay organized for all swimmers to fill the time while scores are being tabulated, everyone is invited to participate! Swimmer's names will be announced, they will be presented their trophies and then asked to take their position on the award stand for recognition and pictures. So be sure to stick around!!

Meet Results: Meet results will be provided on electronic media to all teams that provided entries on electronic media using the Hy-Tek software. "Hard-Copy" of the meet results will be sent to teams only upon request (requests can be made at the timing table after the start of the meet).
