- ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all swimmers holding a 2008 USA Swimming membership card. Any swimmer that appears on the CSI registration exceptions report must come to the meet prepared to show their registration card or they will be deck registered before they can enter the water. A surcharge for deck registration will also apply of \$27.00 year round \$15.00 for seasonal plus the normal registration fee.
- All deck entries must present proof of current registration.** Swimmers must be prepared to show a current card. Age as of July 10, 2009 will determine each swimmer's age group.
- EVENTS:** The 1500 meter Free held on Friday morning will be limited to the first 36 swimmers to enter. No points will be earned when swimming in event #1 and event #2 - the 1500 meter free. Please call Sherry Kurz at 970-824-9657 after July 4th to confirm entries.
- Friday afternoon swimmers may enter up to 4 individual events and two relays.
Saturday and Sunday swimmers may enter up to 4 individual events and 1 relay per day.
All 8 & Under events and relays will start in the water.

Send, as a back up, entries by Hy-Tek COMMLINK file on a 3.5 disk with 2 hard copy printouts of Team Manager "Meet Entries" report.

All other entries must be submitted on CSI master sheets. These forms must include the swimmer's name, age, USS#, team code, event #'s and entry time. Each team will include two (2) copies of master sheet.

TIMES ARE TO BE SUBMITTED IN SHORT COURSE METERS.

The Meet is limited to first 500 swimmers, including host team. No team will be split. Friday afternoon swimmers will not count toward the 500 total unless they compete on Saturday or Sunday.

ENTRY FEES:

Individual events - \$3.50 each (\$0.50 to CSI and \$0.15 to Zone 4).

Relays - \$5.00 each.

Pool Surcharge - \$6.00 per swimmer.

Late entries: \$7.00 for each individual event
\$10.00 per relay.

Full fee must be enclosed with entries.

A CSI Meet Verification form must accompany all entries.

**LATE ENTRIES,
SCRATCHES & RELAY**

All late entries, scratches & relay declarations must be submitted to the Clerk of Course no later than **45 minutes prior to the start of each session.**

DECLARATIONS:

Late fees must accompany late entries at the time of submission to the Clerk of Course.

ENTRY DEADLINE:

All entries must be in the hands of the entry chairman by **6:00 pm Saturday, July 4th, 2009** by either hand delivery, US Mail, or email with hardcopies to follow in the mail. **Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Clerk Of Course no later than 45 minutes before the start of each session, subject to an open lane. Late fees must accompany the entry at the time of submission to the clerk of course.**

AWARDS: All individual events will be scored in each “A” “B” & “C”: 1st through 12th ribbons. Relays 1st through 6th ribbons. **THERE WILL BE NO POINTS AWARDED FOR THE 1500 FREE – EVENTS #1 AND #2.** Places in open events will be made by age groups. Individual High Point for “A”, “B”, & “C” standards categories. (All high point awards will be calculated by computer and then checked “by hand”.) There will be no team scoring.

Awards are to be picked up from the Clerk of the Course at the end of the meet.

MEET MARSHAL:

PROGRAMS/RESULTS: Programs will be available for \$5.00 each. Coaches’ programs will be provided. Results will be available after the meet or mailed within 14 days and will be provided to teams entered in the meet at no charge. Individual final results may be ordered for \$5.00 in the results room.

To submit advertisements in the meet program contact the meet director.

RULES: Current USA swimming rules will govern the meet.
The individual scratch rule will be enforced.
All events will be timed finals.
The MEET REFEREE will have the final authority on all swimming procedures of the meet.
At the Referee’s discretion, individual and/or relay events may be combined by age, sex and/or distance.
CSI/USA swimming guidelines for warm-ups will be used.

Team coaches and parent representatives will be responsible for the behavior and safety of swimmers and their families. Teams and swimmers will be held responsible for any damage to the facility.

parent Entry fees will be waived (with the exception of \$0.50 per splash to CSI and \$0.15 per splash to Zone 4) for one swimmer for one session for each session that a officiates.

NO SMOKING ON POOL DECK OR ANY AREA FREQUENTED BY SWIMMERS
